## Basic Camp Usage Fee Structure



### Guidelines for Year-Round Camping

- Check-In with the Camp Host or Ranger upon arrival to camp.
- Check-Out with the Camp Host or Ranger upon departure of camp.
- Groups must provide adequate Adult Leadership (at least 2 adults) & must adhere to the guidelines within the "Guide to Safe Scouting".
- No ground fires allowed at anytime - Cooking may be done in the following way:
  - Liquid fueled stoves (propane or white gas)
  - Charcoal (depending on fireban)
- Latrines & picnic tables are available in each campsite.
- Water is available from frost freeze hydrant throughout camp. Not all campsites have a frost freeze
- Trash should "Packed Out" when leaving camp. Low impact camping is **ENCOURAGED!**
- All vehicles **MUST** remain on the roads and parking lots. No **VEHICLES ALLOWED** within the campsite.
- No Pets, Fireworks, Firearms, illegal drugs or alcoholic beverages allowed on camp at anytime.
- No Smoking (cigarettes or electronic) allowed in the buildings or tents.
- If an emergency happens, please contact the Camp Host and/or Ranger ASAP. For life threatening emergencies, please contact 9-1-1.

### Refund Policy

Reservations for camping at Tahosa or Peaceful Valley can only be made online or at the Council Service Center. We encourage visitors to pay their camp fees at the time of reservation. A 100% payment is required when the reservation is made. A reservation is tentative until the camp fee is paid in full. Tentative reservations can be replaced or removed by the Denver Area Council at any time.

Full refunds will be available if the roads are closed due to weather. Cancellations made 14 days prior are refundable minus a \$10 service fee. Groups that do not attend camp on their reserved date and do not cancel their reservation 14 days prior to the reserved date are required to pay the full camp fee.

You may request specific campsites and lodges, but requests will be filled on a first come, first served basis. The Camping Department and the Ranger ultimately decide on campsite and facility assignment. Refunds will not be issued for groups that do not receive specific requests.

### How to Book a Reservation Online

- 1 Go to the Year-Round Camping website [www.denverboyscouts.org/camps/year-round-camping/](http://www.denverboyscouts.org/camps/year-round-camping/)
- 2 Choose the Camp you want to Book - Peaceful Valley or Tahosa High Adventure Base
- 3 Under "**CATEGORY**" - Select the options you would like to book.
- 4 On the **CALENDAR** - Select the Start Date/Time --> select the End Date/Time --> select "**RESERVE**".
- 5 Repeat steps 3 & 4 to add more reservations.
- 6 Select "**CHECKOUT**" to complete the process. You will need to add attendee numbers for each campsite to complete the Check-Out Process.

**Payment is REQUIRED to complete all reservations.**
