DENVER AREA COUNCIL TO HOLD "SCOUTING FROM THE HEART BLOOD AND FOOD DRIVE" ON JUNE 23, 2020

Lakewood, Colo—The Denver Area Council, Boy Scouts of America is partnering with Vitalant and Food Bank of the Rockies for a blood and food drive on Tuesday, June 23, at the Council headquarters in Lakewood. All staff, volunteers and donors will adhere to social distancing guidelines, including wearing masks.

Vitalant will be on-site to collect blood donations and will adhere to social distancing guidelines throughout the entire process from check-in to recovery. The pre-screening check-in will include temperature checks. Donors must schedule appointments online. Directions to register are on the <u>DAC website</u>.

The DAC will partner with Food Bank of the Rockies to collect non-perishable food items that will be delivered to Metro Ministries. Metro Ministries delivers food to more than 2,000 families in the Denver area. Directional signage for food drop-off will be displayed throughout the property.
