Guidelines for Year-Round Camping	Refund Policy
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>[ ] Check-In with the Camp Host or Ranger upon arrival to camp.</li> <li>[ ] Check-Out with the Camp Host or Ranger upon departure of camp.</li> <li>[ ] Groups must provide adequate Adult Leadership (at least 2 adults) &amp; must adhere to the guidelines within the "Guide to Safe Scouting".</li> <li>[ ] No ground fires allowed at anytime - Cooking may be done in the following way:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Liquid fueled stoves (propane or white gas)</li> <li>- Charcoal (depending on fireban)</li> </ul> </li> <li>[ ] Latrines &amp; picnic tables are available in each campsite.</li> <li>[ ] Water is available from frost freeze hydrant throughout camp. Not all campsites have a frost freeze</li> <li>[ ] Trash should "Packed Out" when leaving camp. Low impact camping is <b>ENCOURAGED!</b></li> <li>[ ] All vehicles <b>MUST</b> remain on the roads and parking lots. <b>No VEHICLES ALLOWED</b> within the campsite.</li> <li>[ ] No Pets, Fireworks, Firearms, illegal drugs or alcoholic beverages allowed on camp at anytime.</li> <li>[ ] No Smoking (cigarettes or electronic) allowed in the buildings or tents.</li> <li>[ ] If an emergency happens, please contact the Camp Host and/or Ranger ASAP. For life threatening emergencies, please contact 9-1-1.</li> </ul>	<p>Reservations for camping at Tahosa or McNeil Scout Ranch can only be made online or by contacting the Council Camping Office. Camping fees must be paid in full at time of reservation. All cancellations are based on a per person basis and are subject to the following guide-lines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>31 days or more to check in: All paid fees.</li> <li>21 – 30 days before check-in: 50% refund</li> <li>0 – 20 days prior to checking: 0% refund</li> </ul> <p>Any cancellation made after 20-day before scheduled attendance of camp will not receive a refund unless documentation is provided by a medical doctor, or there has been a death in the family. All cancellations will be charged a processing fee of 5% of your total refund. Only Scoutmaster's and camp contact may request refunds. All refunds will be paid to the person who paid made the payment. Adding and/or removing individuals will follow the same refund policy. All refund requests should be submitted in writing to <a href="mailto:camping@denverboyscouts.org">camping@denverboyscouts.org</a>. All refunds are subject to Camp Director approval.</p> <p>You may request specific campsites and lodges, but requests will be filled on a first come, first served basis. The Camping Department and the Ranger ultimately decide on campsite and facility assignment. Refunds will not be issued for groups that do not receive specific requests.</p>

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Go to the Year-Round Camping website <a href="http://www.denverboyscouts.org/camps/year-round-camping/">www.denverboyscouts.org/camps/year-round-camping/</a></li> <li>2 Choose the Camp you want to Book - McNeil Scout Ranch or Tahosa High Adventure Base</li> <li>3 Under "<b>CATEGORY</b>" - Select the options you would like to book.</li> <li>4 On the <b>CALENDAR</b> - Select the Start Date/Time --&gt; select the End Date/Time --&gt; select "<b>RESERVE</b>".</li> <li>5 Repeat steps 3 &amp; 4 to add more reservations.</li> <li>6 Select "<b>CHECKOUT</b>" to complete the process.
