



## Camp Cris Dobbins – 2024 Summer Camp – CampDoc FAQ

- **Is there an additional fee to use CampDoc?**
  - No. This is included in your camp registration.
- **Is there a discount for CampDoc?**
  - No.
- **Why will paper copies not be accepted?**
  - The Greater Colorado Council has adopted the use of CampDoc for the 2024 summer camp season for ease of use for everyone attending camp. This makes it easier for parents to submit med forms, and for the camp to review and approve them. No more tracking down paper copies! This service is provided to everyone coming to camp.
  - Additionally, this puts the pressure on the parents to submit medical forms. They will be reminded via email to complete the form.
  - As we have learned from the COVID-19 pandemic, there is a need to make more things virtual and easier for people to complete on their own.
  - CampDoc also allows us to send mass communications to parents and guardians in the event of an emergency.
  - If there is a need for someone to use paper forms, email our team at [MSRHealth@scouting.org](mailto:MSRHealth@scouting.org) to discuss your situation.
- **How will campers and parents get access to CampDoc?**
  - Registration information submitted into Doubleknot at registration will be taken and uploaded into CampDoc. It is important that information used to register is accurate and up-to-date.
  - Accounts will only be generated for those registered for camp. No “extra” accounts will be given nor will a set number of profiles be given to a unit.
- **Can we use the same account for Dobbins, Cub Scout Adventure Camp, Colorado Adventure Point or NYLT?**
  - Yes. If you are attending more than one of our programs, your profile should automatically merge. If that is not the case, email us at [MSRHealth@Scouting.org](mailto:MSRHealth@Scouting.org) and we will merge the profiles.
- **What if a camper cancels and can no longer attend camp? What if I am switching a registration to a different camper?**
  - Remove their registration in Doubleknot AND [fill out this form](#) when you add or remove a camper in addition to the normal Council cancelation policies and procedures.
- **What happens when I add someone to our registration?**
  - Add their registration in Doubleknot AND [fill out this form](#).



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- **What if adults will only be at camp for a couple of days?**
  - A CampDoc account is still required for everyone attending camp regardless of the amount of time they are spending at camp.
- **How is Part C handled with needing to be signed by a medical professional?**
  - Part C still uses the [BSA Annual Health and Medical Record](#). Campers will be prompted to print out the page, then scan it back once completed.
- **Can we just fill out paper versions and scan them in?**
  - No. Camp Doc is very specific and requires you to enter the data so we can easily use the data. Some forms such as Part C and a couple other forms will be scanned and uploaded, but all other information must be added.
- **Will a unit leader have access to all the medical profiles for the unit?**
  - Yes. One adult who is also attending camp will have access to the profiles for their unit. This is to help ensure completeness and to print a copy (if desired). Units can optionally add one additional adult who can see all profiles. [Fill out this form](#).

- **Can additional emails be added to a profile to access such as another parent?**
  - Yes. Use the MANAGE USERS button.



- **What if two profiles were made for a participant due to them being registered for camp and NYLT?**
  - Use the EDIT button, then Request Profile Merge. OR email MSRHealth@scouting.org to merge the profiles.



- **Can we access CampDoc after camp?**
  - No. After the summer season, you will be locked out. Make sure to download or print a copy of your medical form for your records. **Once locked out, we cannot access your medical form anymore either.**



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- What if a name is spelled wrong, a date of birth is incorrect or something else?
  - Request an edit from your profile.

MANAGE USERS

- Is the “Medication Authorization Form” required to be signed by a doctor?
  - Yes. This form must be signed by an authorized provider.
- Does the immunization form need to be signed by a healthcare provider?
  - Yes. If transcribed, it needs to be signed by a provider. If provided on the official form, no signature is required.
- Other cool features of CampDoc:
  - This summer, when your Scout visits the health lodge, an email will be sent to the parents or guardians, so they are aware!
  - CampDoc makes it easier for the Health Staff to log visits to the health lodge and to keep track of medication administration.

## Camp Cris Dobbins – 2024 Summer Camp – CampDoc FAQ IMMUNIZATIONS:

To attend a summer camp in the State of Colorado, the following immunizations are required for youth participants. Hep B, DTaP, Tdap, Td, Hib, IPV/OPV, PCV, MMR, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella. These immunizations, or an exemption are required if your child attends school in Colorado.

**ADULTS:** We only need to know when your last tetanus shot was. You need to have had it within the last 10 years or provide an exemption form. You can optionally provide more immunization history. A Health Care Provider Signature is **NOT** required.

**YOUTH:** The State of Colorado Child Care Licensing requires immunization records to be on a specific form. Please ask your health care provider to provide you with the “yellow card” with the logo and seal that looks like this.

**A Doctor's office print-out will not be accepted. It must be the “yellow card” OR transcribed to the blank form in CampDoc.**

**OUT OF STATE YOUTH:

If you cannot get the “yellow card” then download the form below in CampDoc and fill in the information. A Health care provider signature **IS** required if the record is transcribed to the form.

This form is to be completed by a health care provider (physician (MD, DO), advanced practice nurse (APN) or delegated physician's assistant (PA)) or school health authority. School required immunizations follow the ACIP schedule. Note: Final doses of DTaP, IPV, MMR and Varicella are required prior to kindergarten entry. Tdap is required at 8<sup>th</sup> grade entry.

**OUT OF STATE YOUTH:** Youth coming from Alabama, Arizona, California, Dist. Of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Maryland, Montana, North Dakota, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia or Washington can upload their state-approved form. If no state approved form is available, use the template in CampDoc.

**NEED A VACCINATION EXEMPTION?** The state provides you with TWO options for this. You may review these options on the [state's website](https://cdphe.colorado.gov/vaccine-exemptions). The signed forms must be uploaded to CampDoc prior to camp. <https://cdphe.colorado.gov/vaccine-exemptions>. BSA vaccine exemption forms cannot be accepted for summer camp.
