All items listed are to be sent directly to the GCC by **June 15 of each year**, except for fall transcript and that is due **December 15 of each year** or it could result in <u>delay and possible forfeiture of the Madden</u>.

Scholars must meet all of the requirements and obligations. Non-compliance must be immediately communicated to the Committee in writing. The Committee has granted waivers and extensions and has the authority to make allowances on a case by case basis if it is in the original spirit of the Madden Scholarship Guidelines.
