Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Open and close the trading post on time.
- Operate the store in a Scout like manner.
- Keep the store including store rooms, restrooms and the exterior clean including trash, windows, floors, dusting and sanitation/disinfecting of machines and store surfaces.
- Assist in maintaining an accurate store inventory.
- Communicate with the Trading Post Manager on inventory needs.
- Keep the store shelves, displays, refrigerators and freezers fully stocked at all times.
- Promote items to customers with the goal of upselling.
- Keep the vending machines stocked. Work with the Manager to achieve this.
- Run the register including processing payments. Keep the cash drawer(s) balanced.
- Sanitize (and winterize at end of season) all concession machines following instructions to maintain cleanliness in the off-season.
- Participate in camp-wide activities.
- Assist in the set up and take down of all camp facilities. Assist with the cleaning of all camp areas
 including restrooms and showers.
- Other duties as assigned.
