Fundraising

This year's fundraising has been exceptional allowing us to proceed with many of our projects. We are still short \$1,500 for benches at the Memorial Wall and \$13,000 for

major improvements to the Rendezvous campfire area. While I know you have already made at least one donation, please consider another or a yearly donation. Projects currently fully funded:

- Memorial Wall
- New Scout Law Signs along the Main Road
- Staff Gifts to reward tenure at camp
- Staff History Wall

Major projects not yet fully funded:

- \$1,500 for a benches and rest area at the Memorial Wall
- \$13,000 for major improvements to the Rendezvous campfire area

Upcoming Project Details

Memorial Wall

This project is to honor and remember the former staff who have passed away. The current plan is for a large piece of corten steel (weathering steel, designed to form a patina of rust) to be installed with the ability to add brass plaques to it. Each plaque would have a single name of a former staff member. We'll also include a single QR code on the wall for people to scan to view the bios of everyone included. It will probably include the words "Gone Home" across the top along with the circle with a dot in it, a symbol that has become ubiquitous within Scouting for those who have passed. It might also include a phrase across the bottom taken from one of the camp songs. Most likely "With you my friends I am there." The plan is to install the memorial wall during the May 4th work weekend.

Scout Law Signs along the Main Road

For several years now, Council has been hoping to refurbish the old wood Scout Law signs along the main road between horses and Dobbins HQ. The PVAA is taking on this project but will be using the same 3 layer composite material that we used for the Scout Law signs along the trail to Rendezvous. This material will look good for many years with little to no maintenance compared to the wood style that was once used. They will be installed during the May 4th work weekend with at least one prep day beforehand to cut, and drill the posts.

Staff History Wall

A "Staff Wall" is in the works. It will feature staff pictures from all previous years The PVAA also hopes to include plaques for our Founding and Lifetime members as well as lists of past Camp Directors and Program Directors. It will be located in Gilwell Hall in the basement of the Dining Hall.

Staff Gifts to Reward Tenure

The PVAA would like to start a tradition of gifts to the current staff based on their tenure. This year everyone will get a patch that indicates how many summers they've been at PV. Anyone who is at 3 summers or more will get a custom sweatshirt hoodie and anyone who is at 4 summers or more will receive a custom yeti coffee mug. The idea being that in the future those at 3 summers would only get the sweatshirt and those at 4 would get a coffee cup. More gifts could be added in future years.

Rendezvous Renovations

Dave Whitner has asked the PVAA to focus on major improvements to the Rendezvous campfire area. He has some equipment already lined up, just needs some more items and the effort to put it all together. Improvements include:

- Speakers
- AV Booth
- Lighting
- More impressive fires
- More seating and fixes to the existing seats
- Improved backdrop with doors

Other Small Projects

Per Colorado state employment regulations, in order to require the current staff to wear a green class A during certain times, the camp MUST have a class A shirt available for them. Even if the staff member currently owns their own green class A shirt, the state inspectors still want to see a pile of shirts available. The PVAA is also leading the way in naming the new mountain bike trails at camp. This would be similar to how trails are named in mountain bike trail networks. Examples are Crevice Crunch, Shiprock Sailing, Ridge Rodeo. We're working on a map as well as custom stickers to display on the trail marking signs. Having the trails named will greatly aid both the summer mountain bike program and the offseason troops who use the trails to prevent confusion and navigational errors.
