Shower Access

CAMP SITE SHOWERS: Showers in individual campsites are for use by the units specifically assigned to that campsite from 6 AM to 10 PM. Adult and youth leadership for the units need to determine the best methods to ensure that the Scouting America Standards are met. At a minimum, all shower users (Adults and Youth) should have a buddy with them to help maintain privacy. We ask that units clean up after themselves, as this is a shared space, and that Adult Leaders make cursory checks of the facilities after use. **NOTE:** The Antero Shower House is the shower/restroom facility for the Amarillo and Billings campsite only.

SAINT JOES REGIONAL SHOWER HOUSE: This shower house is accessible for Staff and Adult Leaders 24 hours a day. The left side of the shower house (from the main entrance perspective) is available for Adult Leaders and Staff at all times; however, from 8 PM to 11 PM, the staff has exclusive use of these facilities. The right side of the shower house (from the main entrance perspective) is available for Adult Leaders at all times. Youth may also use these facilities from 6 AM to 10:00 PM. Troop Leaders must ensure that youth using the facilities have appropriate adult supervision, and the buddy system is used. We ask that units clean up after themselves, as this is a shared space, and that Adult Leaders make cursory checks of the facilities after use.

GATES AQUATICS CENTER: Showers at the Gates Aquatics Center are available from 6 AM to 10 PM daily. There are specific showers available for youth and adults. Troop leaders need to ensure that adequate adult supervision is available for their youth and that the buddy system is used. This is especially important when the facilities are being used outside of program times. We ask that units clean up after themselves, as this is a shared space, and that Adult Leaders make cursory checks of the facilities after use.

GILWELL HALL: Showers in Gilwell Hall are available to youth and adults from 6:00 AM to 10 PM daily. Staff and Adult Leaders have access to the facilities 24 hours a day. Troop Leaders must ensure that youth using the facilities have appropriate adult supervision, and the buddy system is used. We ask that units clean up after themselves, as this is a shared space, and that Adult Leaders make cursory checks of the facilities after use.
